Please call the office to schedule an appointment to have your air conditioners installed. This is needed to ensure they are properly installed so there will be no damage and for safety reasons, there will be a charge for the service. **If you install your A/C please call the office so Maintenance can verify it was installed correctly at your expense.**

Open Window/Door Rule

Spring may be here, but the "No Open Window/Door" rule remains in effect until May 1st or, authorized by Housing. If a window/door is found open before then, there will be a charge of \$50.00, per occurrence. Open windows only when it is warmer outside then your thermostat is set for.

School Lunch Program

Just a reminder that the School Lunch Program is returning this Summer. Times will be announced at a later date.

Gardens

If you are interested in having a flower or vegetable garden please make sure you clearly mark the area.

The Housing Authority is not responsible if your garden has not been properly maintained or marked. The Housing Authority encourages everyone to have a green thumb!

Children are out and about so please take care, drive slowly and pay attention. Parents please keep eyes on your children at all times when they are out to avoid any harmful situation that may arise.
